

A regular meeting of the Bloomfield Board of Health, as established by public record in the Bloomfield Life and posted on the public bulletin board in the Municipal Building in January 2006, was called to order on October 18, 2006 at 6:15 p.m. in the Mayor's Conference Room in the Law Enforcement Building.

Roll Call by Vice-President Gloria Shorter showed the following members to be present:

Absent was James McLaughlin, President.

Also present was Ellen Powley, President of FoBAS, Phil Graziano, Federal Goose Control, Mark Wiley, Board of Education, Trevor J. Weigle, Director and Michele Nemeth, Sr. Clerk Typist.

Minutes of the September 20, 2006 meeting were approved on a motion by L. Jasinski and second by M. Stark.

Vice-President Shorter asked if any member of the public wished to be heard on a matter of public health. No one came forward.

September licenses were accepted on a motion by L. Jasinski and second by P. Barker.

September communications were discussed/reviewed by the Board. The Director informed the Board the Animal Control truck did not meet state requirements for cooling and heating. A new town vehicle was purchased and DPW received the old vehicle in exchange for a car that will be issued to the new Sanitary Inspector.

The Director presented his monthly report for September:

- The Director reported to the Board receiving approximately 27 vials of the 120 vials of flu vaccine ordered. The Director informed the Board of the delay but will schedule the clinic as soon as the remainder of the vaccine is received.

The Director's September report was accepted on a motion by P. Barker and second by L. Jasinski.

The Director discussed the Board's request for a new expenditure report. The Board found the new format presented to be clearer.

The September Financial Report was approved on a motion by L. Jasinski and second by P. Barker.

For her report, Councilwoman Dunigan, Council Liaison asked the Director if he has met with L. Palagano, Township Administrator regarding the 2007 budget. The Director informed the Councilwoman that he has not and the Administrator had not made such a request. The Director informed Councilwoman Dunigan he has begun the process internally.

The following ordinance was repealed on second reading:

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 318,
MILK & MILK PRODUCTS, OF THE CODE THE TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Bloomfield that Chapter 318, Milk & Milk Products is hereby repealed.

Second reading and public comment will be held in the Mayor's Conference Room of the Law Enforcement Building at the next regularly scheduled Board of Health meeting as published in the Bloomfield Life. This Ordinance will become effective thirty (30) days from publication of this first reading and upon second and final reading.

The ordinance was moved on second reading by P. Barker and seconded by M. Stark. All said "yes."

The following ordinance was repealed on second reading:

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 311,
ICE, OF THE CODE THE TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Bloomfield that Chapter 311, Ice is hereby repealed.

Second reading and public comment will be held in the Mayor's Conference Room of the Law Enforcement Building at the next regularly scheduled Board of Health meeting as published in the Bloomfield Life. This Ordinance will become effective thirty (30) days from publication of this first reading and upon second and final reading.

The ordinance was moved on second and final reading by L. Jasinski and seconded by P. Barker. All said "yes."

The Board questioned Mr. Graziano, FGC regarding the on-going geese problem. Mr. Graziano explained the geese will not be reduced until the dog can gain access around the pond. The Director will schedule an appointment next week with Mr. Graziano to show him the path around the pond. The Board questioned Mr. Graziano as to why no monthly reports have been submitted. Mr. Graziano explained FGC did not provide reports but will accommodate the Board. The Board requested that Mr. Graziano address their concern with FGC staff leaving within five minutes of each visit. Mr. Graziano will address the issue. Mr. Graziano explained until the town incorporates all their parks into the program that the geese problem would not be rectified. The Director inquired about the fuel surcharge cost being eliminated. Mr. Graziano stated it would be soon.

The Director advised the Board of the proposed NJ Legislation to eliminate municipal health departments and give that responsibility to the county. He informed the Board that discussions have begun with the New Jersey Health Officer's Association.

The following resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Joanne K. Jaeger, Head Clinic Nurse in the Department of Health & Human Services of the Township of Bloomfield, is retiring from her position effective November 1, 2006 after 26 years of dedicated service to the residents of this Township; and

WHEREAS, Joanne K. Jaeger has properly notified the Director of Health & Human Services and Director of Personnel of her desire to retire from her position as Head Clinic Nurse for the Township of Bloomfield.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Health of the Township of Bloomfield, New Jersey that on behalf of the Department of Health and Human Services and the Residents of this Township, that this acknowledgement and expression of gratitude be made to Joanne K. Jaeger for her contribution to this Township; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be read and spread in full in the minutes of the Board of Health meeting on October 18, 2006.

The resolution was approved on a motion by L. Jasinski and second by M. Stark. All present voted “yes”.

The following ordinance was introduced on first reading:

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 354,
WEEDS, OF THE CODE THE TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Bloomfield that Chapter 354, WEEDS is hereby repealed.

Second reading and public comment will be held in the Mayor’s Conference Room of the Law Enforcement Building at the next regularly scheduled Board of Health meeting as published in the Bloomfield Life. This Ordinance will become effective thirty (30) days from publication of this first reading and upon second and final reading.

The ordinance was moved on first reading by L. Jasinski and seconded by P. Barker. All said “yes.”

The following ordinance was introduced on first reading:

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 322,
NUISANCES, PUBLIC HEALTH, OF THE CODE THE TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Bloomfield that Chapter 322, NUISANCES, PUBLIC HEALTH is hereby repealed.

Second reading and public comment will be held in the Mayor’s Conference Room of the Law Enforcement Building at the next regularly scheduled Board of Health meeting as published in the Bloomfield Life. This Ordinance will become effective thirty (30) days from publication of this first reading and upon second and final reading.

The ordinance was moved on first reading by P. Barker and seconded by L. Jasinski. All said “yes.”

A motion was made by P. Barker and seconded by L. Jasinski to adjourn to closed session at 7:36 p.m.

A motion was made by L. Jasinski and seconded by P. Barker to re-open the meeting at 8:00 p.m.

The filling of current vacancies was discussed in closed. The Board approved the hiring of a part-time nurse, a part-time account clerk and a full-time clerk typist. The Board also approved changing the current Sr. Clerk Typist title to include Deputy Registrar.

A motion to adjourn the full meeting was made by L. Jasinski and seconded by P. Barker. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
