

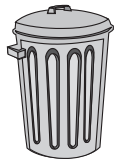

Don't drain grease, **TRASH IT!**

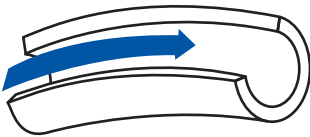
Save money and avoid messy sewer back-ups by disposing of grease and cooking oils in the trash — not down the drain or the toilet.



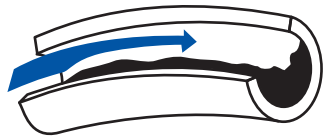
**Put used grease in a container

PIPE CLOGGED WITH GREASE
Poor water flow

- A grease clog can cost you hundreds of dollars to remove and can cause sewer back-ups
- Sewer back-ups are a potential health hazard
- Hot soapy water does not prevent grease clogs! Grease will cool and settle out as it travels through your sewer pipes and into the public sewer system
