Pickleball Demonstration

The Bloomfield Recreation Department will be offering a Free Pickleball Demonstration on Tuesday, June 13th at 7:00pm at Pulaski Park Tennis Courts, 24 Mt. Vernon Ave, Bloomfield, NJ. Rain Date: Wednesday, June 14th at 7:00pm. We welcome you to join in and learn this sport. The Bloomfield Recreation Department will provide the equipment for this demonstration.

Pickleball is a racquet sport that combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis. Two, three, or four players use solid paddles made of wood or composite materials to hit a perforated polymer ball, similar to a wiffle ball, over a net. The sport shares features of other racquet sports, the dimensions and layout of a badminton court, and a net and rules similar to tennis, with a few modifications. Pickleball was invented in the mid 1960s as a children's backyard pastime but has become popular among adults of all ages as well.

The Demonstration will be done by certified Pickleball Ambassadors volunteering their time to demonstrate this new sport. The audience will be encouraged to participate.
