

The ninth regular meeting of the Planning Board of the Township of Bloomfield was held on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 with a start time of 7:00 p.m. Chairman LaQuaglia read the following statement:

“Notice of the time, date, location and agenda of this meeting, to the extent then known, was provided at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the commencement of this meeting, in the following manner, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 231 of the Law of 1975 (The Open Public Meetings Act)”:

- 1.) By posting such notice on the bulletin board of the municipal building and
- 2.) By mailing such notice to the office of the Independent Press, Bloomfield Life, Herald News and the Star Ledger.”

Roll call showed the following members present:

**A memorializing resolution was approved for 110-116 Washington Street, moved by Mr. Zitka, seconded by Ms. Richardson.**

**The application of 102 Broad Street was withdrawn without prejudice, moved by Mr. Zitka, seconded by LaForte.**

#### **CASE A**

Application of 102 Broad Street, LLC. as Applicant and Owner for bulk variances and any such other relief as may be required from the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of Bloomfield to construct an addition on the north side of the building, which is a child care facility, to accommodate new state laws in a Professional Office/Residential PO/R zone on premises known as Map 11, Block 245, Lot 12 better known as 102 Broad Street.

A motion was made by Mr. Zitka to withdraw this application, seconded by Mr. LaForte. All voting members voted yes on the motion and this application was withdrawn without prejudice.
