Leukemia



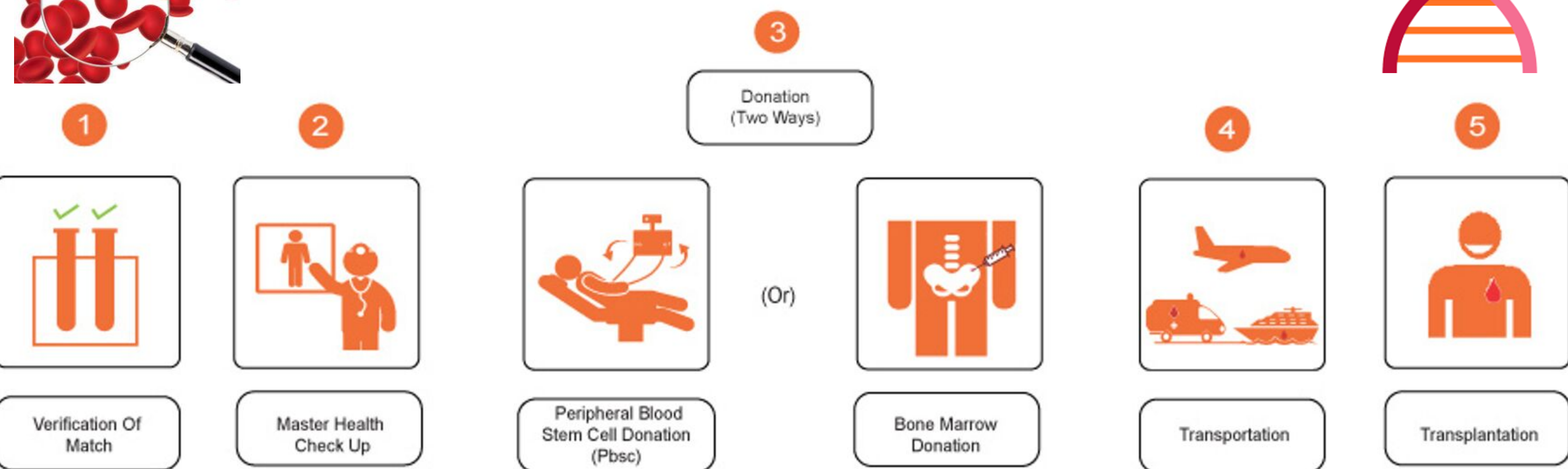
