**** Half day pricing is only available if you are enrolled in the BOE Extended School Summer Learning Program. This program will run concurrently with camp weeks 1-4 and will run from 8:30am to 12:30pm - Monday - Thursday. Children enrolled in this program can attend summer camp from 12:30pm to 4:00pm Mon - Thurs & all day Friday (8:00am - 4:00pm).**

We have re-implemented a multiple child discount for 2022 which will begin when your children register for 7 or more weeks of camp (regardless if its at Forest Glen and/or Demarest). To calculate your total registration fee you would add up the total amount of weeks all of your children will attend for the entire summer.

EXAMPLE #1: One 4 year old attending Forest Glen for 5 weeks, One 1st grader attending Forest Glen for 6 weeks

11 Weeks = \$1,480

If your child is enrolled in the BOE Extended School Summer Learning Program and will attend half days you would total the number of weeks for the half day program and add any additional full weeks for that child and any other children

EXAMPLE #2: One 5th grader attending 4 weeks of 1/2 day camp and the same child attending the remaining 2 full weeks. AND your 2nd grader attending 6 weeks of full day camp

4 weeks of 1/2 day camp (\$360) + 8 weeks of full day camp (\$1,180) = \$1,540

Special Needs Inclusion pricing is the same as above.

Special Needs Self-Contained Camp (9:00am - 2:00pm) = \$100 per week *





The Dial-A-Ride Program is a free transportation service that is available to all senior citizens over the age of 60 and any resident with a disability or handicap. Eligible residents can schedule rides by calling the recreation department during regular business hours: Monday – Friday from 8:30AM to 4:30PM.

All callers are given a specific pick up time in order to transport them to their destination in a safe and timely fashion. Rides are predominately for medical purposes but also include transportation to the barber/beauty shop, visiting sick relatives, gravesites, supermarkets and local shops as well as to volunteer jobs and recreational activities.


This is a “curb to curb” service that picks up residents and takes them to any destination throughout Essex County. To schedule an appointment please call 973-566-7194.



Put Your Garden on the Pollinator Pathway Map

Is your garden buzzing with bees, birds and butterflies each summer? Are your plants mostly native perennials? And do you keep your garden pesticide-free? If so, then you likely have a pollinator garden and the Bloomfield Environmental Commission would like to put you on the map. As part of its ongoing effort to create a "pollinator pathway" throughout Bloomfield, the commission is building a map of

pollinator gardens in the township.

Bloomfield's pollinator pathway is anchored by gardens in public spaces, including Watsessing, Brookside, Liongate and Brookdale Parks, the children's library/civic center and community gardens. Many individuals also maintain pollinator gardens and the commission would like to include as many of these as possible on a pollinator pathway map that will be posted on its webpage. (An early version of the map accompanies this article.)

NJ Idling Laws

This is your reminder that NJ's anti-idling law prohibits idling of any gasoline or diesel-powered passenger and commercial vehicle longer than three minutes. This prevents the air pollution caused by idling that may jeopardize the health, welfare, or safety of the citizens or degrade the quality of life.

This law applies year-round and does not exclude pre-warming and pre-cooling of interior cabins, or any time a vehicle is stationary for short stops that could last longer than three minutes (e.g., to run into a convenience to buy something).

PLEASE NOTE: This does not apply to: buses discharging or picking up passengers; motor vehicles stopped in a line of traffic; motor vehicles being or waiting to be examined by state or federal motor vehicle inspectors; motor vehicles whose primary and/or secondary power source is utilized in whole or in part for necessary and definitively prescribed mechanical operation other than propulsion, passenger compartment heating or air conditioning; emergency motor vehicles in an emergency situation; and/or motor vehicles being repaired.

Any person violating this statute will be subject to a fine of not less than \$100 nor greater than \$2,500 for each violation by local health officials, the Bloomfield Police Department, and the local code enforcement office.

Bloomfield Department of Health and Human Services

Nursing Services conducts more than 1,500 health screenings per year for the general public, including more than 400 screenings for children. Their focus is to achieve the greatest good for every residents using nursing strategies that promote and protect the public's health. The service area provides no-cost/ low-cost screenings and services, administers vaccines, conducts communicable disease investigations, and manages cases for specific diseases. They partner with community agencies to optimize services.

Human Services is the Bloomfield's outpatient mental health and social service center. Residents can schedule an appointment or discuss available services by contacting the division during regular business hours. Residents may also be referred through schools, social service agencies, hospitals, or physicians. Special attention is given to Bloomfield's most vulnerable populations: the elderly, people with special needs, and children. The staff includes licensed clinical social workers, a psychiatrist, and state-licensed mental health clinicians.

Health Education hosts community health education programs, such as alcohol and drug abuse control, tobacco use prevention/ cessation, nutrition, injury control, and chronic diseases education. Programs are coordinated in collaboration with other community agencies and are tailored to fit the needs of the community/group with a goal to increase life expectancy and improve quality of life.

Environmental Health conducts routine sanitary inspections of more than 500 business establishments and service providers within the Township of Bloomfield. Citizen complaints generate another 600-700 inspections, many of them requiring multiple field visits. Other year-round duties include childhood lead poisoning investigations, food handler training courses, analysis of potable water samples, etc. Vital Statistics records and safeguards documents pertaining to the most important events in a person's life: birth, marriage/ civil union/ domestic partnership and death. The information is often necessary to obtain a driver's license, a passport or to secure a job. For a small fee, the office provides the following documents: marriage/ civil union licenses, affidavit of domestic partnership, certified copies of births, marriages, civil unions, domestic partnerships, and deaths. The Registrar of Vital Statistics also researches records for funeral directors, attorneys, municipal offices, government agencies, and the general public.
