

Transportation Services

The Bloomfield Parks, Recreation & Cultural Affairs Department provides free transportation services to our residents, 60 years and older and/or with disabilities Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 3:30pm.

The Senior Citizen Bus Service is a fixed route service that stops at predetermined locations and brings residents to Bloomfield shopping center in various parts of town.

The Dial A Ride Program is a “curb to curb” service that picks up residents from their home and takes them to and from the doctors (well visits) on a first come first served basis. Eligible residents can schedule rides by calling the Bloomfield Parks, Recreation & Cultural Affairs Department’s Transportation number 973-566-7194 during regular business hours. Appointments must be made at least 72 hours in advance and are on a first come first served basis.

Commuter Shuttle Service

The North End Shuttle and South End Shuttle is back up and running every Monday through Friday (except municipal holidays) from approximately 5:30am to 8:30am in the morning and approximately 5pm to 8:30pm in the evenings. The **North End Shuttle** has four morning routes traveling from the corners of East and West Passaic Ave. south on Broad St. to the Bloomfield Train Station on Lackawanna Place.

The South End Shuttle has six morning routes traveling east on Belleville Ave., South on Willet St. and west on Montgomery St. to the Bloomfield Station.

Both shuttles operate on a fixed route and riders will be picked up at designated times and locations along the route.

In the evening, both shuttle busses pick up riders coming off the trains and take them home in reverse order of the morning routes.

During inclement weather or NJ Transit equipment failure a **Level #1 or Level #2 service** may be implemented.

Shuttle bus passes must be purchased at the Civic Center located at 84 Broad St. Monday to Friday 8:30am to 4:30pm and Wednesday nights from 6pm to 8:30pm. Other times can be arranged by calling 973-743-9074 during normal business hours.

A 50 ride pass costs \$25 dollars. Upon entering the shuttle bus, your pass will be “punched.”

50 years of work by artist Mark Richardson will be on view at the Bloomfield Civic Center, 84 Broad St, Bloomfield, NJ 07003 from October 15th - November 11th. Works will include sketches, collage and paintings.

Mark was a retired Vietnam Army Veteran, graduate of The Cooper Union College and a lifelong lover of jazz. He had an extensive collection and used the energy from this music as the backdrop of the creation of his art. He began sketching and painting as a young boy and his work continued to evolve throughout his life.

He was often inspired by something as simple as the way light bounced off the pattern of lines made from helicopter blades in motion. This helicopter fascination is evident in many of the works he created while serving in Vietnam. He received an honorable discharge and for the years after, he worked as a draftsman for Gimbles, drove a public bus for the Manhattan Department of Transportation and in retirement he opened a small coffee shop in Brooklyn.

Mark 'the artist' was an intense, reclusive and talented creator of beautiful pieces of work. Mark the uncle was a devoted supporter of all things possible for his only nephew and niece. Mark the brother was a worthy debating opponent, kindred spirit, adversary and trusted confidant for the things that mattered. This same passion and respect for relationships made him a proud individual who wanted to be known for his art because of the effect his work had on people.

Mark died in April 2017, losing his battle with bone and prostate cancer. Now in 2022 the Township of Bloomfield is fulfilling his dream.

Fallen Officer Memorial Ceremony and Dedication

On Friday, October 21st, the Bloomfield Division of Public Safety commemorated two Bloomfield Officers who died in the Line of Duty while serving the Township. The ceremony took place at Bloomfield Police Headquarters.

The first, Detective William F. Mertz who died in the line of duty on December 18, 1915 while attempting to arrest a murder suspect.

The second, Detective James Peri, passed away on October 22, 2021 from complications of COVID-19. Members of the Bloomfield Police along with his family members will be present. Both Detectives names will be placed on a monument in front of Bloomfield Police Headquarters.

"Although Detectives Mertz and Peri served more than a hundred years apart, they share a legacy with all members of the Bloomfield Police Department of bravery, commitment, and a willingness to make the ultimate sacrifice to protect our great community. No matter how much time passes our gratitude to them and their families will never waver, and with this commemoration they will always have a permanent place in Bloomfield and our hearts," **said Township of Bloomfield Mayor Michael Venezia.**

"While Detectives Mertz and Peri served this agency decades apart, they both shared a common commitment to service to our great township that led to them both making the ultimate sacrifice in our profession. This monument being dedicated today will literally etch their names and legacy in stone. As they were members of this great department in life, their memories will resonate with each and every member of this agency for generations to come. ONE DEPARTMENT, ONE FAMILY!!!!!" **said Bloomfield Public Safety Director Samuel DeMaio.**



Environmental Commission

“Leaf Me Alone”

It's common practice in autumn to cut back gardens and fire up the leafblowers. But did you know that this can be harmful to birds and beneficial insects? According to the Bloomfield

Environmental Commission, the larvae of many beneficial insects such as fireflies and butterflies overwinter under leaves and others stay warm in the hollow stems of “dead” plants. These insect larvae also provide food for our winter birds as do the seeds from this past summer's flowers if left standing until springtime. Meanwhile, leaf blowers cause air and noise pollution while destroying every living thing in their paths.

Of course, you need to clear leaves from walkways and other areas where they may become a safety hazard, and “leaving the leaves” isn't always an option for everyone. But if you must clear leaves, the Commission suggests putting away the leaf blower and raking them into a garden area. Not only will they help birds and beneficial insects but they'll break down into mulch and save you money in the spring on chemical fertilizers. Plus, it's good exercise. A win-win for you, your yard and the environment.

The Township of Bloomfield has partnered with Recycle Coach to help residents reduce waste and become better recyclers. The Recycle Coach App is available for FREE, download on Android and iPhone.

Recycling and Waste Disposal Information:

Biodegradable bags are picked up on your recycling day. When you are filling your biodegradable bags, please put only grass, twigs, leaves, etc. (vegetative waste) into the bags. Please no garbage, papers, dirt, rocks, etc. as the Township becomes subject to fines when the bags are carted to the Vegetative Recycling Facility. In addition, bags can weigh no more than **50 lbs.**, and if possible try to make them even lighter than that (tough on the back).

Not accepted in regular Garbage or Recycling:

- **Tires** (Car, Truck, Motorcycle, etc.) – *bring to a local tire shop/store*
- **Electronics** - Drop off Electronic Items (TV's, Computers, etc.) at the Department of Public Works Recycling Depot **every Saturday from 9:00am -1:00pm.**
- **Construction Debris** – *must be disposed of privately*

Metals and appliances (NOT electronics) are picked up **every Tuesday. You must** call Department of Public Works, **(973-680-4127)**, no later than 3:00 pm on Monday for a scheduled Tuesday pickup.

- Accepted metal items include bed frames, metal curtain rods, metal hangers and loose metal pieces. Metal swing sets must be disassembled.
- Accepted appliances include refrigerators, stoves, microwaves, and air conditioners. Remove any appliance doors. Place items door side up for pickup.

- Metal paint cans are considered bulk waste. They are picked up on your second weekly garbage day. (Latex paint only, completely dried out).

If you are unsure whether an item is metal, call DPW at **973-680-4127**.

NJ Bag Ban Information

Rodent Prevention in Bloomfield

The best way to prevent a rodent infestation and contact with rodents is to remove the food sources, water, and items that provide shelter for rodents.

Rodents pose a significant health risk to our community since they transmit a number of diseases.

If you see rodents on your property and/or recognize increased rodent activity in your area, please contact the Health Department for an environmental assessment at 973-680-4024.

Spotted Lanternfly

Spotted Lanternfly (SLF) is a serious invasive pest with a healthy appetite for our plants and it can be a significant nuisance, affecting the quality of life and enjoyment of the outdoors. The spotted lanternfly uses its piercing-sucking mouthpart to feed on sap from over 70 different plant species. It has a strong preference for economically important plants and the feeding damage significantly stresses the plants, which can lead to decreased health and potentially death.

As SLF feeds, the insect excretes honeydew (a sugary substance) which can attract bees, wasps, and other insects. The honeydew also builds up and promotes the growth for sooty mold (fungi), which can cover the plant, forest understories, patio furniture, cars, and anything else found below SLF feeding.
