

# Notice: Recycling for Commercial Properties and Contractors in Bloomfield

Every year, all 565 municipalities in the State of New Jersey are required to submit a recycling tonnage grant report to the Department of Environmental Protection. It is the law in New Jersey (NJ AC 7:26A-10.1) that everyone, whether they be a resident, commercial business or institution, must recycle.

If you manage the solid waste and recycling program for a commercial property, institution, or contractor doing business in Bloomfield and haven't reported your recycling tonnage generated in Bloomfield during 2024 to the Township yet, please reach out to the Recycling Coordinator with that information **by Friday, April 4th**.
