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PUBLIC ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION REQUIRMENTS

-PAC- Requirements-

1. **Event date and times** must be specifically listed on the application and only the alcohol in section (2) can be consumed during the times of the function. **If function does run over, the alcohol consumption cannot continue.**

Example: Dinner under the stars event will be from 7:00pm -11:00pm

- Consumption designated area will close by 10:30 to allow patrons to finish their beverages and exit the area.
2. **The Permit and application only allow** for beer, wine, or malt alcoholic beverages to be consumed. Spirit alcohol (whiskey, vodka, tequila, gin, grain alcohol, etc.) cannot be consumed at the event.
 3. **Event consumption area and location** must be specific and clearly defined on the application. IE (The consumption of alcohol is only permitted on Washington St. between Glenwood Ave and Farrand St.)
 - The event area must be enclosed by barricades.
 - The predefined consumption area within this location must be enclosed not entire street
 4. **Event participants** shall arrive with their alcoholic beverages packaged and enclosed/never opened
 5. **Any establishments** within the events area that is licensed to sell alcohol, must sell it as an unopened packaged product and the patron must leave the establishment before opening the alcoholic beverage.
 6. **Any establishments** within the events area that is licensed to sell alcohol, is not permitted to allow patrons to enter or exit the establishment with opened alcoholic beverages.
 7. **Any establishments** within the events area that is licensed to sell alcohol, is not permitted to stay opened and sell alcohol past the time allowed by its license.
 8. **No person shall** bring, consume, or possess any alcoholic beverage that is under the age of 21.
 - The event coordinator is responsible for monitoring any underage consumption.
 - Any person under the age of 21 must be accompanied by someone over the age of 21 if they want to enter the enclosed consumption area
 9. **There shall** be **NO** advertising by the event coordinator or any participating business that beer, wine, or malt products can be consumed at the event.
 10. A minimum of 2 police officers will be scheduled to work the event during the times of the event.
 - Anytime a permit is granted.

-NOTE-

These regulations are established under the New Jersey Statute 2C:33-27 and or town ordinance 122 Alcoholic beverages. Violations are a disorderly person's offense or fall under ordinance General Penalty 1-15 violation and penalties.

It shall be the responsibility of the event coordinator and the participating businesses that these rules and regulations are followed. They could be held accountable if these rules and regulations are not followed.
