Memorandum of Understanding between the Township of Bloomfield Police Department and the Bloomfield Board of Education.

This Agreement is entered into this day, \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ 2016, by and between the Township of Bloomfield Police Department, hereinafter referred to as the "Township PD" and the Bloomfield School District, hereinafter referred to as "School District".

For and in consideration of the mutual promises, terms, covenants, and conditions set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Purpose of Agreement. The purpose of this Agreement is for the Township PD to assign two (2) police officers to provide law enforcement services as specified herein; one (1) full-time to Bloomfield Senior High School and one (1) full-time to Bloomfield Middle School.

The Police officers will work with school personnel in providing alcohol and other drug education, maintaining a safe campus environment, serving as law enforcement problem-solving resource persons, and providing the appropriate response regarding on school campus or school related criminal activity.

2. Terms. The term of this Agreement shall be from September 2016 until the end of the 2016-2020 school year. It is understood that at the end of the four-year commitment, the Township PD and the School District would have the option of discontinuing this program or agree to mutually support this initiative in the future.

During days the schools are not in session, the officers shall perform regular police duties as determined by the Police Director.

3. Relationship of Parties. For purposes of this Agreement, the police officers assigned to the School District shall be considered to be employees of the Township PD and shall be subject to its control and supervision.

The assigned officers will be subject to all general orders, policies and procedures in effect for Township of Bloomfield Police Officers, including attendance at all mandated training and testing to maintain New Jersey State Law Enforcement officer certification.

The parties agree that non-police personnel supplied by the School District to accomplish the goals of this Agreement (i.e. teachers, administrators or other employees of the School District) will not

be considered a Township employee and that no rights under Township civil service, retirement or personnel rules accrue to such person.

4. BOE Reimbursement. The Board of Education will be responsible according to the attached four (4) year payment schedule which was adopted on September 13, 2016.

5. Time and Place of Performance. The Township PD will endeavor to have police officers available for duty at their assigned school each day that school is in session during the regular school year. The Township PD is not required to furnish substitute officers on days when regular School Resource Officers are absent due to illness or police department requirements (i.e. training, qualifications, or other Township Emergencies.)
