
Attached for the Mayor and Councils Approval is The Cops in School Program - School Resource Officer Retention Plan and Memorandum of Understanding between the Township of Bloomfield Police Department and the Bloomfield Board of Education.

This retention plan covers the years 2012 – 2016. This agreement does not increase the Police Department manpower, as the officers are currently deployed to the Middle school and the High School. **Officers are already budgeted so this does not increase or affect the Police Budget.**

If agreed upon, this will extend the current agreement which ends June 2012 at the end of the current school year.

This shared Services Agreement has been in affect since 2004, with two prior four year agreements which has mutually benefited both the Bloomfield Police Department and the Bloomfield Board of Education.

The Police officers will work with school personnel in providing alcohol and other drug education, maintaining a safe campus environment, serving as law enforcement problem-solving resource persons, and providing the appropriate response regarding on school campus or school related criminal activity.

2. **Terms.** The term of this Agreement shall be from September 2012 until the end of the 2015-2016 school years. It is understood that at the end of the four-year commitment, the Township PD and the school District would have the option of discontinuing this program or agree to mutually support this initiative in the future.

During days the schools are not in session, the officers shall perform regular police duties as determined by the Chief of Police.

3. **Relationship of Parties.** For purposes of this Agreement, the police officers assigned to the School District shall be considered to be employees of the Township PD and shall be subject to its control and supervision.

The assigned officers will be subject to all general orders, policies and procedures in effect for Township of Bloomfield Police Officers, including attendance at all mandated training and testing to maintain New Jersey State Law Enforcement officer certification.

The parties agree that non-police personnel supplied by the School District to accomplish the goals of this Agreement (i.e. teachers, administrators or other employees of the School District) will not be considered a Township employee and that no rights under Township civil service, retirement or personnel rules accrue to such person.

4. **Budget Expenditures.** The Township PD and the School District will maintain a budget through 2015 – 2016 school years. The School District will be responsible for fifty percent of the aforementioned officers' salaries and benefits. The Township PD will be responsible for the remaining fifty percent for the 4 year lifetime of this agreement. Attached to this document is the breakdown of costs to the various agencies for the School Resource Officers (Cops in School Program).
5. **Time and Place of Performance.** The Township PD will endeavor to have police officers available for duty at their assigned school each day that school is in session during the regular school year. The Township PD is not required to furnish substitute officers on days when regular School Resource Officers are absent due to illness or police department requirements (i.e. training, qualifications, or other Township Emergencies.)






